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## **Starting a New “Project”**

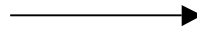
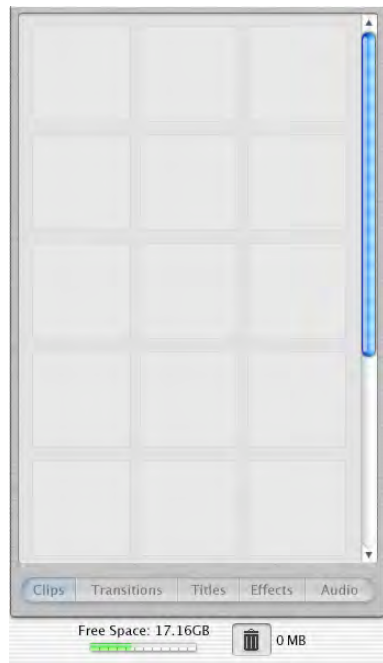
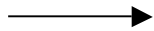
- Step 1: After opening iMovie application, go to “File” and “New Project”

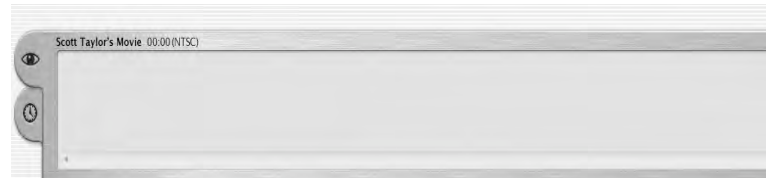

## Identifying the Pieces of the “Puzzle”

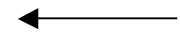
Clip Pane

Timeline

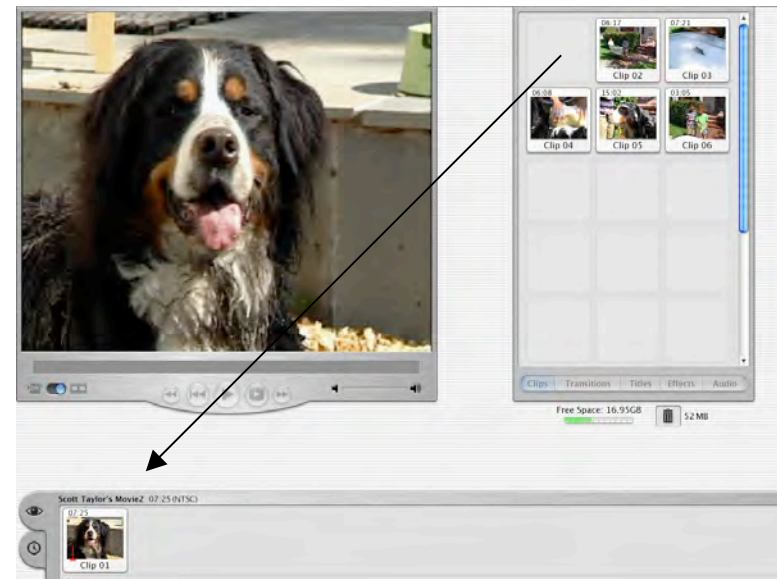

# Digital Imagery- Videography

## Step 1: Working With Clips

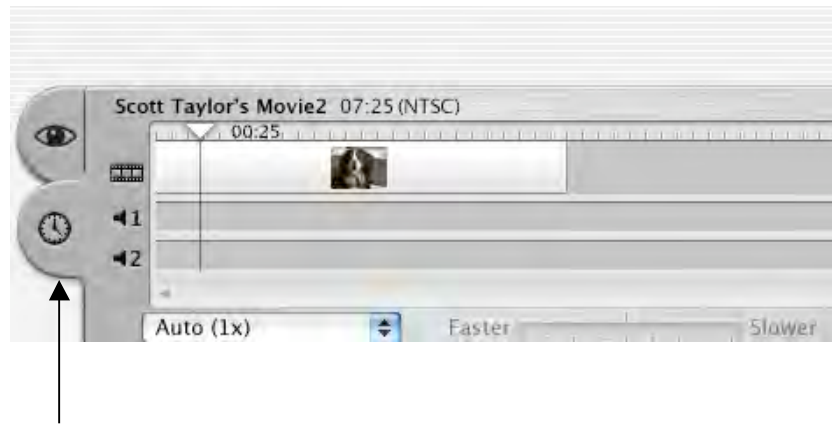
1. Drag a clip from the Clip Pane to the Timeline
2. Select the clip in the Timeline and press the Play Button on the Viewer to preview

# Digital Imagery- Videography

## Step 2: Working With Clips- Details



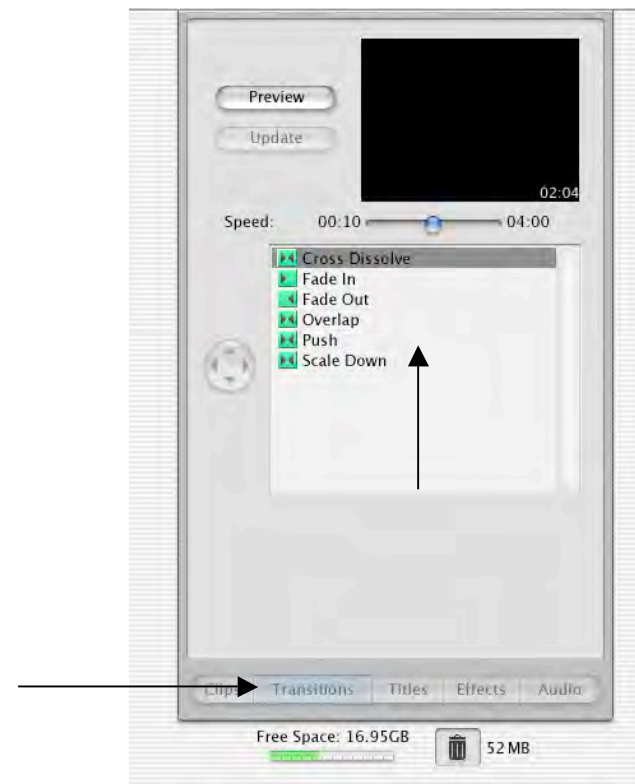
Select the detail function from the Timeline to work with the clip more carefully

# Digital Imagery- Videography

## Step 3: Working With Clips- Adding Transitions

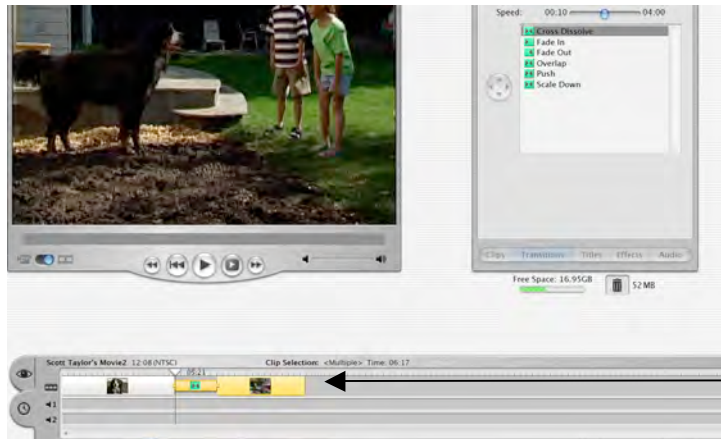
1. Select “Transitions” from the Clip Pane
2. Pick a transition and drag it to a location in the Timeline

# Digital Imagery- Videography

## Step 4: Working With Clips- Adding Transitions



1. Drop the transition in the Timeline
2. Wait for the transition to “build”

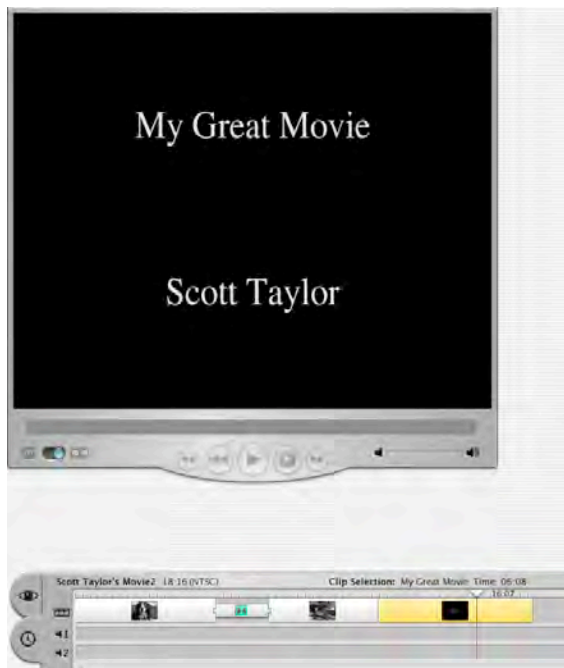
## Step 5: Working With Clips- Adding Titles

1. Select “Titles” from the Clip Pane
2. Type a title and drag to the Timeline (similar to adding a transition)

## Step 6: Working With Clips- Adding Titles

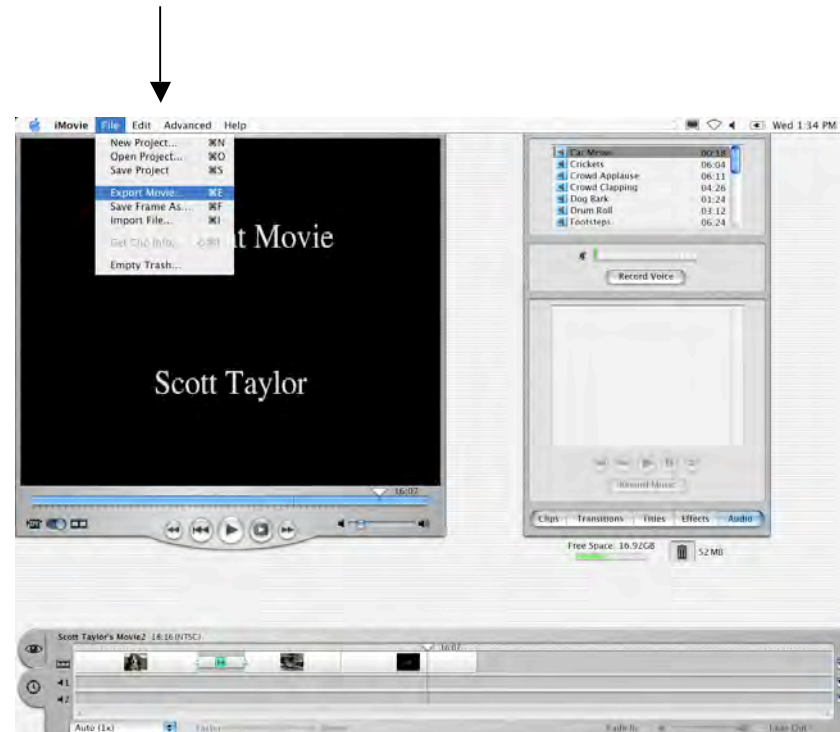
Wait for the Title to build (similar

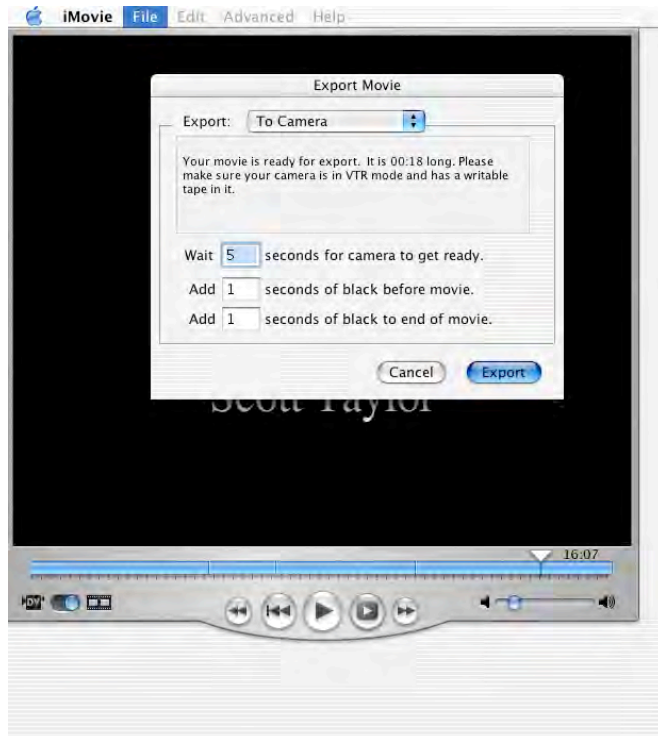
## Step 7: Exporting the Movie

Go to File and select “Export”

## Step 8: Exporting the Movie- Options

Select “To Camera” to create a videotape

## Step 9: Exporting the Movie- Options

1. Select “To Quicktime” to create a digital computer file
2. Select proper setting according to use of file (i.e. posted on web, burned on a CD)
